Request for Proposal**

The FSM Department of Health and Social Affairs seeks the services of a licensed distributor/vendor or organization to perform/deliver any of the projects listed below. Proposals could include one or more projects as preferred, ONLY from the list as indicated, below:

Work to be performed:

1. Conduct CPR and BLS Train-the-Trainer Course Project
2. Conduct Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) Courses Project
3. Provision of Pharmaceuticals and Medical Supplies for Emergencies Project
4. Provision of Emergency Medical Equipments Project
5. Provision of Emergency Medical Equipments for Children Project
6. Provision of Standby Power Generator with at least 40KVA Project
7. Provision of Personal Protective Equipments (gloves, masks, HAZMAT gears and supplies) Project for Zika Virus, Ebola, and other infectious diseases prevention
8. Production Public Health Risk Communication Messages/Videos, especially on Zika Virus, Ebola, Poisoning and other emergency public health concerns in the FSM Project.
9. Isolation Room rehabilitation Project at public hospitals in Kosrae, Pohnpei, Chuuk and Yap; that is based on acceptable standards and specifications to be provided by each respective State Health Director.
10. Provision of Isolation and Bio-Safety Equipments that meet CDC and WHO standards for Ebola Assessment and Treatment Purposes

General Requirement and Procedure:

Any licensed individual, business or organization may submit a proposal to the Department of Health and Social Affairs for any of the tasks listed above detailing the services, timeline, and the costs of such provision. Interested bidders could provide a bid for a single project or for all projects depending on company's interests.

The Department of Health and Social Affairs reserves the right to reject any and all proposal due to the costs and appropriateness of services being proposed by any bidder.

Proposal Content:

The proposal shall include all the following:

1. Name, Address and Contact Information of Individual, Business, Company or Organization
2. Business Licenses or Professional Credential and Certificates of past performances
3. Services that will be provided
4. Timeline of Services to be provided
5. Cost of Services and Schedule of Payment, training, shipping and warranty
